- 1. Minimum 1M.Sc.(Nursing) faculty for each specialty i.e. Medical Surgical Nursing , Child Health Nursing, Obstetrics & Gynae. Nursing, Community Health Nursing & Mental Health is required for basic programme.
- 2. Part time nursing faculty will not be counted for calculating total number of faculty required for a College.
- 3. Irrespective of number of admissions, all faculty positions (Lecturer to Professor) must be filled.
- 4. For M.Sc.(N) program mme appropriate number of M.Sc. faculty in each specialist be appointed subject to the condition that total number of teaching faculty ceiling is maintained.
- 5. All nursing teachers must possess a basic University or equivalent qualification .They shall be registered under the Maharashtra State Nursing Registration Act, 1966.
- 6. Nursing faculty in Nursing College except tutor / clinical instructors must possess the requisite recognized post graduate qualification in nursing subjects.
- 7. All teachers of nursing other than Principal and Vice-Principal should spend at least 4 hours in the clinical area for clinical teaching and / or supervision of care every day.
